GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR CONNECTION TO PUBLIC STORM SEWER SYSTEM

Completion of application does not grant approval. Additional permits, fees and requirements may apply. Connection is for private storm water only and shall not include sanitary sewer or other foreign waste materials. A plan shall be submitted to the City for approval before any connection is made to the public storm sewer system. This plan shall detail the construction of the proposed drain system, including the type of material.

1. The drain system, including the tap, or connection point, shall remain a private system and shall be maintained by the property owner(s). The adequateness of the design of drain system has not and will not be evaluated by the City.
2. If the drain system is to be a perforated pipe, the pipe used shall be wrapped with a geotextile fabric that adequately prevents the transport of soil into the public sewer system.
3. The drain system pipe may be connected to the public storm sewer system at a manhole or inlet structure if pre-approved by the City. Connection and location of connection shall be at the discretion of the City.

- 4. The drain system pipe shall be connected with an Inserta Tee fitting, or pre-approved equal. The tap and fitting may be purchased and installed by the Street Department. Please call for pricing.
- 6. The City shall be contacted at least twenty-four (24) hours before the drain system pipe is connected to the public storm sewer structure to allow scheduling of the required inspection(s).
- 7. The City shall inspect and approve the completed connection construction before backfilling is done at the public storm sewer structure.
- 8. Once installed, this drain shall not be removed without the written consent of the City.
- 10. If it is determined by the City that, due to design or maintenance, this drain is a detriment to the public storm sewer system, the connection of this drain to the public storm sewer system may be removed and shall be property owner's responsibility to find alternative route.
- 11. The City does not make any warranty on the capacity of the public system, or any other potential failures that could cause a blockage or back-up of the public system onto private property.
- 12. Property owner(s) shall protect, indemnify, and hold harmless the City of Cameron from any loss, damage, liability, and expense for all injuries, including death to persons or damage to property directly or indirectly arising or from the performance of the work described above.
- 13. I/We, the Owner(s) of Record of the property shown on the above-referenced plan, hereby certify that the information provided on this form and on any additional data attached hereto is true, complete, and accurate; and that I/we have reviewed the conditions listed above and listed on said plan and agree that the conditions listed above and listed on said plan shall be binding upon the owner(s) of record of the property shown on this drainage improvement plan and upon their heirs, successors, and assigns:
